## **Training group buys building on west side**

A non-profit group that helps train minorities and women for apprenticeships within the construction trades has purchased a building on Milwaukee's west side.

The Wisconsin Regional Training Partnership bought the 31,000-square-foot building, 3841 W. Wisconsin Ave., for \$850,000 from Advance Cleaning Products Inc., said Tom Gale, of Equity Commercial Real Estate LLC. Gale, along with Tony Stevens of RFP Commercial Inc., brokered the building sale.

The partnership will move its Center for Excellence program, a joint initiative it operates with the Big Step organization, from its cramped facility at 532 E. Capitol Drive. The partnership will lease a portion of the building to Advance Cleaning Products, which will remain at that location.
